About the role

This role would suit applicants embarking on a career in learning, seeking to develop delivery experience. Support and guidance will be given throughout the project to enable successful candidates to reflect and develop their skills. The learning team will be based in a purpose-built Learning Studio delivering workshops to schools, colleges and community groups on Tuesdays-Fridays. Workshops focus on critical analysis and collaborative making.
